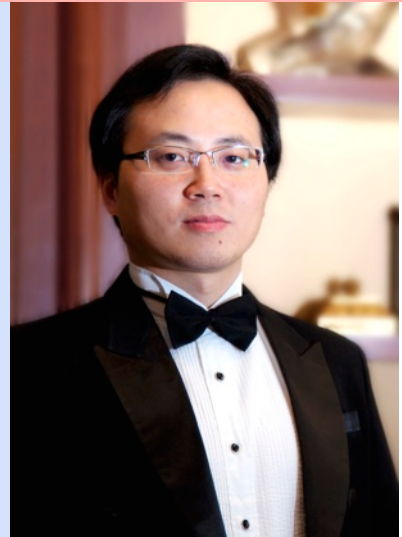


Virginia de Blank
